PALM SUNDAY – The Sunday before Easter, recalls the triumphal entry of Christ into Jerusalem during the last week of His life.

Reading II: Philippians 2:6-11

Gospel: Matthew 26:14 – 27:66

AN INVITATION TO PRAYER

Gracious God, the energy and emotion of a parade can generate joy. Yet the joy of your parade into Jerusalem turned so quickly to pain signaling the sacrifice of your own self. Let this day remind us that while emotions can be fickle, your faithfulness and love remain true. May we see in the giving of your life the power to give ourselves for others simply for love. When life's struggle sears our souls or sacrifice strips us of hope, strengthen us with your spirit that strode into Jerusalem to face death even as palm branches were strewn before your path and the crowd cried "Hosanna in the highest."



HOLY THURSDAY – The Thursday in Holy Week which is properly called Maundy Thursday commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist (which is later celebrated on the special feast of Corpus Christi). The mass denotes joy and thanksgiving.

GOOD FRIDAY – This day commemorates the Passion and Death of Christ. The faithful are asked to abstain from meat and poultry and to respect the solemnness of the day by refraining from watching TV, listening to the radio and music, and from other entertainment.

EASTER SUNDAY – The first Sunday after the full moon following the vernal equinox (between March 22 and April 25) commemorates the Resurrection of Christ from the dead. Easter determines the dates of the movable feasts and the number of Sundays after Epiphany and Pentecost.
