

## **The Five Glorious Mysteries**

**Sign of the Cross:** In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.

**The Apostles Creed:** **I believe in God**, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son Our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into Heaven, and sitteth at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

**Our Father**, Who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

P. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

**R. Be it done unto me according to Thy word.** (*Hail Mary*)

P. And the Word was made flesh.

**R. And dwelt among us.** (*Hail Mary*)

P. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

**R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.**

**P. Let us pray:** Pour forth, we beseech You, O Lord, Your grace into our hearts, that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Your Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may, by His Passion and Cross, be brought to the glory of His resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.

P. Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord

**R. and let perpetual light shine upon them** (three times)

**P.** May they rest in peace. Amen.

P. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

**Sign of the Cross: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.**

### The Resurrection – Faith

Jesus did as he foretold, he rose from death, thus securing for us everlasting life in heaven with him and his father. The apostles and Mary are hiding in the upper room in fear of the future. When the Holy Spirit, the Advocate Jesus said he would send, comes to them they are filled with the gifts they need to go out into the world: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. We receive these same gifts at our baptism and confirmation. I pray

that I can use these gifts to share the love of Jesus and the story of his good news.

#### The Assumption of Mary – Devotion to Mary

Mary is taken to heaven to her rightful place with Jesus where she intercedes for us in prayer. I imagine her excitement at being with her son again, and her pleasure at being in heaven with God. I pray for her intercession and help in growing closer to Jesus, while asking her to help me love him more. She will keep pointing the way toward her son.

#### The Coronation of Mary – Eternal Happiness

Mary is the Queen of Heaven and Earth. She listened to God's will and stayed true to his plan for her life. Mary was not spared suffering but her reward in heaven is great. She is our queen too, and if asked she will help us in all facets of our life. I imagine her lovingly looking down at us and her happiness at our requests for help. I pray for her humility, patience, and trust.
